


A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT

Juke van Niekerk (center) and Titia de Zeeuw (left) of Stichting Liniebreed Ondernemen (SLO) are in a team of three and together with the EFFORTS secretariat, the power behind the organisation of the **EFFORTS European Fortress Day**, organised this month for the first time in 9 European countries. Dutch SLO stands for heritage preservation by means of sustainable, socially responsible and economic use of Dutch Forts and Waterlines. SLO supports entrepreneurship, takes care of national marketing and communication for forts and waterlines, connects markets and governments, boosts collaboration and offers a helping hand with product development.

Founded with financial support of Europe, SLO developed a lively network of heritage entrepreneurs, owners, governments and volunteers. Working all together to get forts, fortresses and waterlines in the picture of a wide audience. As EFFORTS member, we are proud to use our own national model by being EFFORTS of assistance with the organization of the first European Fortress Day! And we are looking forward to see you all in November in Venice to evaluate this first joint event that is our European Fortress Day!

EFFORTSearch FOR EUROPEAN COOPERATION : CULEMBORG

The town of and EFFORTS member Culemborg (Netherlands) is looking via EFFORTS for European partners in a fortified heritage Virtual Reality project.



Culemborg is a vital town that wants to present its hospitality with its historical identity. The city wants to address the attractiveness in spatial planning of the historical structure and locations. The area development of the past 10 years has been very successful. Culemborg has invested in the defence line 'New Dutch Waterline'. Partly due to the restoration of historical elements, but much more it was the unpacking of the historical sites and landscape instead of development. Culemborg will also start for instance a project of renewing the entrances of the historic city. Not by rebuilding the gates but to reconstruct hospitable city entrances. Together with the investments in the historic streets and the market square, this forms a recovery plan for the historic city center. Culemborg will invest \in 1,5 mln. Itself in this. Also, Culemborg is setting up a virtual reality heritage project: the return of **Cuylenborgh castle as a Virtual Reality castle.**



The castle Cuylenborgh played a major role in the history of Culemborg between 1270 and 1675. Disappeared since long, the most valuable historical site of Culemborg is now a cultural city park. The city wants to bring this forified heritage back to life through Virtual Reality. "A lot of Virtual Reality (VR) has been researched in recent years. One of the most important conclusions is that a movie is something you have seen and VR is something you have experienced. If you do it the right way, a visit to the VR castle is just as valuable as a visit to a preserved stone castle. We also want to add education to the VR so that visitors can really learn something from a visit to our castle." The VR experience is shown on the spot where the castle used to be. **Via EFFORTS, Culemborg municipality is now looking for European partners for this common Digital Economy or Structural Funds project.**

HORIZON EUROPE : research and creativity for heritage

Boosting creativity and preserving cultural heritage: the innovative potential of Cultural and Creative Industries : EFFORTS gives the floor to Christian Ehler, European Parliament Horizon Europe rapporteur in his report on the European Commission's proposals for the new EU Research Programme :

"Cultural and creative industries (CCIs) are those based on cultural values, individual creativity, skills and talent with the potential to create wealth and jobs. They include architecture, archives and libraries, artistic crafts, audio-visual (including film, television, video games and multimedia), cultural heritage, design, fashion, festivals, music, performing arts, books and publishing, radio and visual arts. Creativity is a key factor in the digital revolution, not only for the value it brings but due to its irreplaceable contribution to a changing society where artificial intelligence is transforming the needed skills. CCIs are a driver for growth and have an impact on innovation in many industries, e.g. the wider use of design in manufacturing industries (automotive, aeronautics, medical, consumer products) add value to products, services, technologies, processes and market structures. The European Parliament has already recognized the potential for CCIs in its report "on a need for a coherent EU policy of cultural and creative industries". Innovative and research-oriented European CCIs are also able to preserve linguistic and cultural diversity and pluralism. In Horizon Europe, the innovative potential of CCIs should be fully exploited by establishing creativity and design as a crosscutting issue that will be integrated in projects throughout the programme in order to foster new technologies, business models and competences as well as translate creative and interdisciplinary solutions into economic and social value. Cultural Heritage is an integral part of the CCIs and its exploitation and preservation should be strengthened. In order to facilitate research collaboration, exchange of know-how and traditional skills and content, the Rapporteur has also proposed that a "Cultural Heritage Cloud" should be created."
