A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear members and sympathisers,

I am very proud to present the first Newsletter of 2019, a new year of interesting action for our organization.

At the EFFORTS Congress in November, we adopted the EFFORTS Declaration of Venice, in which we present the position of EFFORTS on the reuse of fortified heritage in Europe to the European decision makers. This year will indeed be a year of changes : a new European Parliament, a new European Commission. With an updated policy position, we can inform our stakeholders on the importance of the reuse of built military heritage. As an ever growing international organisation, we also need to ensure our representative base. This means we need to have a solid membership. We have now sent out the 2019 membership fee invoices to our members. But we also will attract more colleague-sites from all European countries. I strongly believe that consolidating our membership in all European countries will put more weight in our positions in Brussels and with the European institutions. I therefore have asked the board to intensify our **membership policy** by working along each country's historic defence lines. In doing so, I am confident that rapidly EFFORTS will become the **representative European network or fortified heritage**.

In the meanwhile, EFFORTS is awaiting the go-ahead for a first partnership in an **Interreg** application. EFFORTS is also working with some of you on a possible **cooperation on these defence lines**. For this we will organise a dedicated meeting later in the spring. In the meanwhile, we are also seeking possible modification in the **European Heritage Label** rules so as to make it possible for European lines to join this European 'Unesco' label. EFFORTS is also striving to participate in the **EU Week of Cities and Regions in October 2019**. EFFORTS is also working with its partners towards the creation of a **Heritage Coalition**, a grouping of built and nature heritage associations in Brussels.

SEPTEMBER 2019 : the second EFFORTS EUROPEAN FORTRESS DAY



The preparations for the second EUROPEAN FORTRESS DAY are well underway. In order to present Europe's forts and fortifications to a larger European publicand international partners together with the Dutch foundation Stichting Liniebreed Ondernemen we are organizing the second edition of the Europe-wide event 'European Fortress Day'.

2018, the European Year of Cultural Heritage, was at the basis of this initiative. In 2019 we will couple European Fortress Day to the European Heritage Days again. 'Days' indeed, since not all countries organize their Heritage Day at the same Day in September. This way your Fortress Day activity will be easier to catch on in your city or region. We were 69 fortresses in 9 European countries doing the first EUROPEAN FORTRESS DAY 2018. All present at the EFFORTS Congress in Venice pledged to participate in the new version of the European Fortress Day n 2019.

All EFFORTS members are invited to open your sites on a day in that month and participate. *How can you participate in European Fortress Day?*

- **PAY your EFFORTS MEMBERSHIP FEE for 2019** (www.efforts-europe/membership/). From this year on, only EFFORTS Members can participate.
- **OPEN YOUR SITE TO THE PUBLIC** You are doing this anyway probably and organize a EUROPElinked action.
- **LOAD THE COMMUNITY** Feed the 'Linie' community (for Dutch members of SLO) or the EFFORTS community (by sending photos to <u>info@efforts-europe.eu</u>). We will make sure that your activity is highlighted at the international website of European Fortress Day.
- **USE THE LOGO** Insert the European Fortress Day logo in all communication material, like the EUROPEAN HERITAGE DAYS. This is free publicity and it is a fitting connection to the European fortress theme. Make an online flyer and present your activity in the online media. And of course, you can put up a banner on your website to highlight your European involvement.

- SEND PHOTO US MATERIAL FOR A SHORT PAN EUROPEAN FILM

All participants for Innovative fortification participation to the European Fortress Day compete for the annual EFFORTS Award that will be presented at the annual EFFORTS Congress. In 2018 this award went to the Sibenic Fortress of Culture, represented by Mrs. Đurđa Vrljević Šarić.

EFFORTS EUROPEAN FUNDING PROFESSIONALS NETWORK : EFFORTS – International Fortress Council meeting

On 25 January in 's Hertogenbosch, a delegation of EFFORTS met in the framework of EFPN with the International Fortress Council delegation, led by its president and secretary general Cees Neisingh.

EFFORTS and IFC discussed joint European opportunities and will present a Memorandum on a common Knowledge Agenda. EFFORTS and IFC will also join forces for a Knowledge Center, connect on EU projects on digitalisation (creating a Europe wide fortification dictionary) or other EU funding possibility research or on proposals like self-sustainibility. IFC will promote participation in the European Fortress Day.

This meeting was the first meeting in the framework of the **EFFORTS European Funding Professionals Network**. The second meeting will be on defence line cooperation in Europe in May-June in Olst-Wijhe. In the EFPN EFFORTS organizes the direct connection between the European relations and funding professionals of its members. In the framework of EFPN, EFFORTS organizes ad hoc meetings on European cooperation opportunities. Participation is voluntary. European Parliament Committee on Culture and Education votes on CREATIVE EUROPE Programme

On 20 February 2019, the report of Silvia Costa, Italian member of the European Parliament (EP) on the post 2020 Creative Europe programme has been adopted by the EP's Culture Committee. The Creative Europe programme structures EU subsidies in the creation of (amongst others) heritage European and cross-border cooperation and networks. One of the focuses is the creation of jobs in creative and other economic sectors. EFFORTS, with its Declaration of Venice, together with the Europa Nostra Berlin Call to Action, supports the European Parliament and the Commission in their endeavor for securing enough EU support for European heritage networks. In this programme, as it does in other

EU programmes like Interreg, EFFORTS will also, with the help of its members, strive for the creation of built heritage projects.
