HORIZON 2020: Open Call BEYOND CUTURAL TOURISM

In the frame of the recently launched Horizon 2020 funded project "Beyond Cultural Tourism (Be.CulTour)", the European Regions Research and Innovation Network (ERRIN), is opening a call for regional representatives responsible for cultural tourism to join the Be.CulTour Community. Cultural tourism, including heritage assets, will be at the heart of the peer-learning programme.

12 selected applicants representing their local and regional innovation ecosystems will have the opportunity to benefit from a fully funded peer-learning scheme which will follow a pilot / mirror approach.
