- ✓ **Elected by the General Assembly** for 2 years (max. 8 seats)
currently 3 architects/historians, 2 tourism/economy experts

Nature, role and responsibilities of the scientific boards of Cultural Routes

- Cooperation for the exchange of knowledge and experiences, interlink of disseminated knowledge,
- Initiation of the production of relevant knowledge, theoretical and practical research, interdisciplinary analysis
- Networking between the tourism industry and the cultural heritage industry through a clear cooperation project with a research agenda,
- Development of multi-layered networks with other routes' boards, but also with universities, researchers and NGOs at local, national and international levels,
- Establish strong partnerships with different authorities and stakeholders at the international, European, national and local levels.




Activities of the FORTE CULTURA Scientific Committee 2020/21




