


■ Project summary



The 22 partners of the transnational project Walls and Gardens want to manage their military heritage in an ecologically sound way and improve its accessibility to their citizens, visitors and tourists alike. The various interpretation centres will stand for a better understanding of ancient military objects and will point out the special meaning of this heritage as the traces in the landscape of the former, ancient borders. 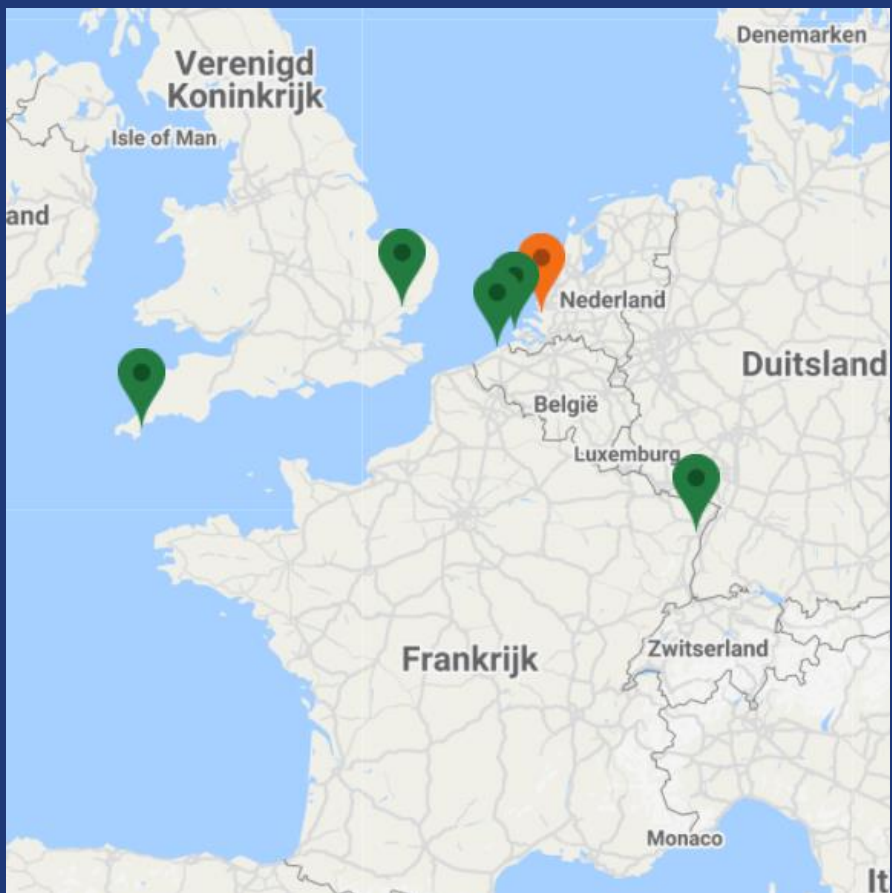
