The period of January - June 2023 saw the establishment of the Platform of Flemish Fortified Cities in Herentals and Dendermonde, on 8 June with EFFORTS and its members Regionale Landschappen, Oudenaarde, Zoutleeuw, Menen, Antwerp and Simon Stevin VVC, with Wommelgem, Stabroek met Stafort, Schans Landmolen, supported by Herita, Toerisme Vlaanderen, Agentschappen Onroerend Erfgoed and Natuur en Bos. The conglomerate welcomes all fortified cities in Flanders which want to share experience and projects. The Platform's moto is 'Stronger Together' and is a direct result of the cooperation between EFFORTS Europe and its member Regionale Landschappen in the 'Recapture the Fortress Cities' EU Interreg Europe project.


VISIT TO GARDERHOJ FORTET COPENHAGEN

The EUI support urban areas of all sizes with innovative actions, capacity and knowledge building, policy development and communication on sustainable urban development. The first call for Innovative Actions was launched back in October 2022 and focused on the New European Bauhaus demonstrators. In May, the **second call for innovative actions** will be published, with an even higher budget of 120 million euros. This **call is intended to support**:

- Greening of cities
- Sustainable tourism
- Utilization of talents
- Capacity building for cities

The European Urban Initiative will soon launch a range of capacity building tools and activities. EUI's work on capacity building for cities is based on **two main objectives**:

- improving cities' capacities to design and implement sustainable urban development strategies, policies and practices in an integrated and participatory manner

• Culture Moves Europe

On the 10th of October, the European Commission launched **Culture Moves Europe**, its new permanent mobility scheme for artists and cultural professionals, as well as a first call for individual mobility, during a high-level event in Brussels. Benefiting from a total budget of €21 million under the Creative Europe program for a three-year-period (2022-2025), Culture Moves Europe becomes the largest European **mobility scheme for artists and cultural professionals targeting all Creative Europe countries** and sectors covered by the Culture Strand of the program. Culture Moves Europe connects artists, creators, and cultural professionals from the countries participating in the Creative Europe program. The mobility scheme is particularly focused on emerging artists.

This Academy shows how a virtual reconstruction of a historical site is made, based upon the example of the 17th century <u>fortress of Lillo, Belgium</u>. This fortress was reconstructed by Visual Dimension bvba, in close cooperation with the <u>Centre for Urban History at the University of Antwerp</u> and the European <u>'Recapture the Fortress Cities' (RCF) project</u>.

The Belgium-based VirtuaFort research project built a Virtual Reality application around Fort Lillo and its immediate surroundings. We had the pleasure to feature this project in depth in our #LTMThursday campaign to learn more about the methodologies and workflows applied. Follow the button below to learn more about their experiences and accomplishments. Virtuafort is a partner of the EFFORTS Europe supported EU Interreg Europe project Recapture the Fortress Cities.

This Academy does not focus on one specific software solution, but rather on the methodology and workflow of virtual reconstruction, from archive to operational 3D application. Sessions are interactive, with live multiple-choice questions plus exercises to be completed by participants in-between sessions.

This leads to significant economic effects and has further strengthened the view of cultural heritage as a strategic resource for its economic impact, but also for its role in creating and enhancing social capital and achieving the goals of smart, sustainable and inclusive growth. At the same time, economic effects have been distributed unequally – often being more prevalent in urbanized areas – and the exponential growth of tourism (notwithstanding the dip during the Covid-19 pandemic) created issues of both over- and underexploitation.
