A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear EFFORTS network member,

I am happy to announce a new season for the presentation of Europe's fortress heritage. EFFORTS is in its 7th year or existence and we have grown from a European Interreg project to Europe's federation of fortified sites.

EFFORTS is organising its focus, as decided by its last General Assembly in 2023, towards European and other project network platform on the development of fortified heritage. In the meanwhile, EFFORTS will continue even more to support the development of national fortification sites cooperation. We welcomed in 2023 the Belgian Flemish Platform of Fortress Cities, and this year we do this with the Ukrainian partners, our Belgian partners (Wellington Barrier). More countries are to follow and we welcome this bottom-up structuring of our European network of cities and regions.

We are therefore happy that the site of our founding member Suomenlinna (the 'Finnish fortress') in Helsinki (FI) will host the next EFFORTS Board meeting. We are planning to prepare proposals on next years' priorities for the EFFORTS General Assembly (online in June and presented at the next EFFORTS congress in the fall). EFFORTS experts will also participate there in the discussion of Suomenlinna's longtime UNESCO status.

We are also working hard on the EFFORTS and partners' project idea of an Interreg Europe project on the innovative use of governance for fortification heritage development. In the meanwhile we are boasting quite some news from our Belgian partners. However, we are obliged to change the planned venue of the EFFORTS Congress. We have a few sites that are willing to host this annual high-profile network event. More on this in the next EFFORTS news.

Finally, EFFORTS is putting emphasis on the people that make out our member sites. All EFFORTS network members can use the hashtag **#iamefforts** to support the human effort in EFFORTS. Join the network!

I wish you a fantastic Spring season and this not without thinking about our Ukrainian EFFORTS members. They are still suffering terribly from the horrific war forced upon them.
























EFFORTS organised the second annual conference of the Platform of Flemish Fortified Cities in Belgium on 5 March in Oudenaarde (BE). With a keynote from the Belgian Prime Minister, Alexander De Croo on the importance of cultural cooperation in Europe, and a welcome by mayor and EFFORTS President Marnic De Meulemeester, 10 Belgian Cities in Flanders presented their possible fields of cooperation, like cooperation on the drafing master plans for fortress city planning, environmental or digital projects and intra-Belgian defense lines. We welcomed the active input of the city of Menen (with alderwoman Griet Vanryckegem), Diest, Zoutleeuw, Herentals, Dendermonde, Antwerp and Leuven. With the participation of leper and Lier. Also the town of Stabroek (and Stafort), and Antwerp's fortress line Schans Landmolen are EFFORTS members in Flanders.

The period of January - June 2023 saw the establishment, as a result of the **EU Interreg Europe project in Belgium 'Recapture the Fortress Cities'**, of the Platform of Flemish Fortified Cities in Herentals, after many meetings between city representative with EFFORTS. In Herentals in 2023, EFFORTS members members in Flanders signed the Flemish Fortress Cities Platform's **Declaration of Intent 'Stronger Together'**, in the presence of Regionale Landschappen, supported by Herita, Toerisme Vlaanderen, Agentschappen Onroerend Erfgoed, Simon Stevin VVC, and Natuur en Bos. The conglomerate welcomes all fortified cities in Flanders which want to share experience and projects. The Platform's moto is 'Stronger Together' and is a direct result of the cooperation between EFFORTS Europe and its member Regionale Landschappen in the 'Recapture the Fortress Cities' EU Interreg Europe project.

WELLINGTON BARRIER 2024

As part of the work of EFFORTS to help cities in EU countries organize around the development of fortification heritage, the idea was put forward in 2020 to collaborate with EFFORTS Europe member, the city of Namur and the other cities that were part of the former 'Wellington Barrier' (1814/1815-1830 and later) in a contemporary supra-regional tourist development project. This project is being set up by the interested partner cities in Flanders and Wallonia, with the aim of linking this fortification line to local and regional tourist access. A first sub-project, a traveling exhibition, will be presented in the citadel of Namur at the end of 2024, together with the participating partners. It will then be exhibited in prominent places in the participating cities. The participating cities are Dendermonde, Menen, Mons, Namur, Oudenaarde and Philippeville. The other Wellington cities and sites that support this EFFORTS network are Ath, Charleroi, Liège, Ypres and Maastricht (NL) and the sites Forte Napoleon in Ostend (Herita) and the Citadel of Antwerp (Konhef site). All other Belgian cities that want to participate in these Wellington projects can contact EFFORTS (see below). This project is EFFORTS' Belgian city partners participation in the 200-year anniversary of the Belgian Independence in 2030. More information on the official presentation of the project will follow.

"What was this 'Wellington Barrier'? After Napoleon's defeats in Leipzig and his exile to Elba, the great powers in Europe put their affairs in order. The First Treaty of Paris (1814) would ensure this. To avoid creating a spirit of revenge, France was allowed to retain its pre-1792 borders. On the other hand, the country was surrounded by a belt of medium-sized states created to counterbalance a possible new French aggression. In this political context, the new United Kingdom of the Netherlands was founded the current Netherlands and Belgium - and it was decided to build a series of defenses along, among other things, the French northern border, the later Wellington Barrier. In 1814, both the British Commander-in-Chief, the Duke of Wellington, and the Dutch General Cornelis Krayenhoff made proposals to the new monarch of the Northern and Southern Netherlands, William I, on how the new

borders and defense position should work. After the Belgian independence in 1830, these defenses played a pivotal role in the establishment of a Belgian defense system." (Dennis van Nieuwenhuijzen, EFFORTS expert).






